The heavens were opened and the voice of the Father thundered: *{from <u>Mark's</u> account 9:7}* This is my beloved Son, listen to him.

Gospel MT 3:13-17 {*This is <u>Matthew's</u> account as handed down in his tradition.* Sometimes People are concerned that the Gospels don't completely agree on every detail. Really the agreement in ESSENTIALS is stronger because of those minor differences.}

Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. John tried to prevent him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and yet you are coming to me?" Jesus said to him in reply, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then he allowed him. After Jesus was baptized, *he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for him,* and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him.

And a voice came from the heavens, saying,

"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." [clearly refers to Isaiah's Prophecy

Remember I said this incident is in all 4 Gospels. John's Gospel does not describe it, but refers to it.

Fitting: like the mitzvah washing makes us fit to enter the Temple; XT is here washed fit <u>to BE</u>COME the new Presence of God, <u>to be</u> HIS TEMPLE.

So a Blessing of Waters: Rivers and Lakes [As at PGH] often is done on this feast.

> [clearly refers to Isaiah's Prophecy which Matt says is fulfilled!]

...he came up from the **water** and behold, the heavens were opened for him,... We too, when we emerge from the waters of Baptism, WE will have the Heavens opened for us. As happened with John & XT at the Jordan, God will say (of us) This is my beloved son. ..
